Rutland CCSD 230 has been testing the safety of its water for years. We regularly test for a wide variety of possible contaminants including lead. Test record are available that show that Rutland water has consistently tested well. Last year the State of Illinois required specific faucets to be tested. A few of our faucets were found to have traces of lead that largely disappeared after running the water for a few seconds. We replaced or put out of use all faucets with any trace findings. Rutland's water supply continues to have excellent test results. This issue was with a few specific faucets. If you have any questions, please call me at Rutland.
